GRACE BUILDS

Besides the regular weekly and monthly flow of gifts, all of which are important to our future, several uniquely special things have happened since the new year.

In January, the school received a \$40,000 gift. In February, we were blessed by a \$100,000 gift. In March, the school and church each received \$100,000 checks as partial payment from the estate of former church members who have gone on to be with the Lord.

In the time of waiting on FEMA to finalize their commitment of grant money, we are in a positon to evaluate ways to advance the project and use more of the funds to pay for the building spaces. A potential next step that would be most doable would be to finish Phase II (all the outdoor projects and infrastructure), a cost of approximately \$2 million.

While a couple of million dollars would not finish current buildings, much less start those in Phase III, it is possible to complete Phases I & II so that all FEMA money would go toward the buildings.

If you have not yet given, or you gave some time ago and have had time to catch your financial breath, now would be a great time to help move us forward on our next step toward completion of the future of Grace Ministries!

MAY 10 FROM 6-8 PM


