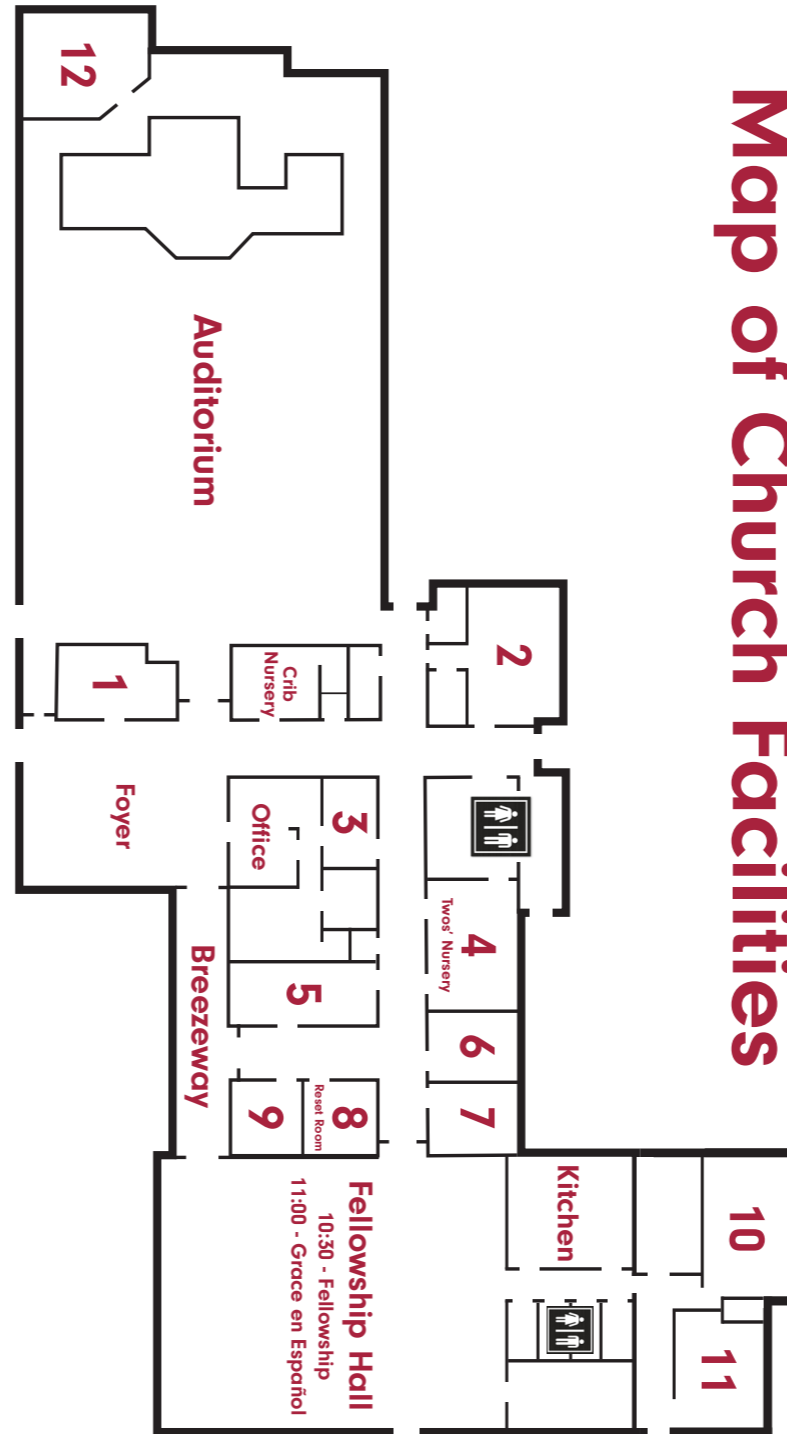
FATHER/DAUGHTER DRIVE-IN
